- Each applicant will be held responsible to complete **all** of the components of the application, including:
 - *The application*
 - *A signed copy of the Judges Code of Ethics*
 - *A 3X5 color photograph of the applicant dressed as if Judging and event,*
 - *4 references from active WCHA Members (Judging and Education Committee members are precluded from participating in the reference process and will be notified of such in case they are requested to provide a reference. Applicants are responsible to print off reference forms and distribute to each individual requested to provide a reference.)*
 - *A check in the amount of \$100.00 as the application-filing fee.*

In addition, all applicants must be a member of WCHA. If you are currently not a member, you must join and will find the membership application form on the WCHA web site at: <http://www.conformationhorse.com/>

All components of the application must be submitted to the WCHA office to be received by the filing cut-off date of June 15, 2010. Applicants are responsible to ensure that those individuals submitting references on the applicant's behalf complete the reference form and the reference providers submit the references by the June 15th filing deadline.

- The Judging and Education Committee will review each applicant's file and determine those individuals who will be invited to participate in the testing phase of the application process.
- You should expect to hear from the WCHA office the first or second week in July 2010 regarding whether you will be invited to participate in the testing phase of the application process, scheduled to take around August at the AQHA Youth World Show in Oklahoma City. The testing phase will consist of:
 - A written test
 - Live judging
 - Interviews
 - And oral reasons

A clinic/seminar will also be held as a part of the process the day before the testing and will be confirmed upon notification to participate in the testing phase in early August.

- We expect to make our final Judges selection within 30-45 days of the Event in Oklahoma City and will contact each applicant who attends the Oklahoma City event. The number of Judges selected will be determined based on the number of applicants as well as the number of events we feel will be held during 2011.
