2011 STALLION NOMINATION FORM

I, _____ (owner/agent) nominate my stallion,

to the WCHA Breeder's Futurity Program for 2011. By doing so weanlings and yearlings sired by my stallion are then eligible for competition in the WCHA Breeder's Championships scheduled for September 22, 23, 24, 25 - 2011 in Des Moines, IA.

Nominator Agrees To The Following Terms and Conditions:

Nomination Fee: \$ _____

Nomination fee is equal to the advertised stud fee of my stallion in 2011, or \$600.00, whichever is greater. If standing at Private Treaty the nomination fee is the highest amount collected from any mare in 2010, or \$600.00, whichever is greater. By nominating my stallion I agree that no mare will be bred prior to Feb 1 of any year my stallion is enrolled in the program. Once enrolled into the program all stallions are automatically enrolled for all subsequent years until stallion owner notifies WCHA that he no longer wishes to participate, stallions will be advertised as participating stallions throughout the year. \$50.00 of each stallion's nomination will be retained by WCHA to help offset costs of advertising and office expenses associated with the futurity program. Stallion Nomination deadline is April 15 but late enrollments into the program will be accepted at double the advertised stud fee. Stallions enrolled early will receive more recognition from advertisements.

1. Nominator has option to pay in two payments, 1/2 when sending in nomination form and the balance payable April 15th. If this option is used two checks must accompany this nomination form:
 - a. Check # 1 in the amount of 1/2 of nomination fee.
 - b. Check # 2 for the balance of nomination postdated April 15, 2011.
 - c. Make all checks payable to WCHA Breeders Futurity
2. Breed Registration Papers: A copy of each stallion's registration papers must accompany this form. All Paint, Pinto, Palomino, Buckskin and Quarter Horse stallions are eligible for nomination.
3. No Refunds. Violation of any rule or amount of stud fee nomination will result in immediate suspension from the program with all fees non-refundable.
4. Stallion owners must be or become members of WCHA.
5. The WCHA Futurity committee reserves the right to distribute stallion nomination funds, and add or subtract various classes, as the futurity program grows with the bulk of the nomination fees awarded to the weanling futurity classes with smaller percentage to the 3 yearling classes. The stallion owner's allocation to the color purse will remain the same.

OPTIONAL ALLOCATION TO COLOR PURSE:

_____ Yes, I want 25% of my stallion's nomination fee allocated to a separate color purse that all offspring of stock horse type, registered with either Paint-Pinto-Appaloosa-Palomino or Buckskin breed associations, can earn monies. The remaining 75% will go into the open and non-pro futurity purses for all breeds.

_____ No, I want 100% of my stallion's nomination to be allocated to the open and non-pro purses for all breeds. (50% to Non-Pro purses and 50% to Open purses)

I hereby hold WCHA, and/or any person(s) representing WCHA, harmless for any and all damages that may occur from my enrollment in this program. Furthermore, I agree to abide by all the conditions of stallion nomination and futurity rules. x _____ Signature Date _____
