- We offer several classes within multiple divisions of competition, at first glance it might appear confusing, however if you first identify what type of competitor you are (Intermediate Non Pro, Regular Non Pro or Open)
- **“You Are Required To READ The Rules Section” at the end of this entry form pages.**
- **Please take extra time to fill in EVERY line on the entry form and PLEASE print legibly, if your form is missing items or not readable, we can't process.**
- An “Intermediate Non-Pro Class” applies to the exhibitor, not the horse.
- “Limited Class”, this applies to the horse in the two-year-old and three year & over classes. Please take a few minutes to read all the Limited Eligibility Rules before filling out your entry form.
- See **Rules on ATTIRE and changing of exhibitors** in the attached rules section.
- **NO LEASES ARE ALLOWED IN WCHA.**

WEANLING AND YEARLING ENTRY FORMS ARE ON PAGE 2, 3 & 4.

- Weanling Splits: 3 Splits: Junior-Median-Senior, Read Rules For Split Dates
 - ✓ Senior Weanlings: Jan 1 – Jan 31st
 - ✓ Median Weanlings: Feb 1 – March 4th
 - ✓ Junior Weanlings: March 5 and Later (These splits apply to both fillies and colts)
- **Yearling Mare Splits: *To assist our competitors so they can possibly bring additional horses.***
- **See Rules where owners with multiple horses in junior or median splits can move one horse up into older division so that same exhibitor can show both horses. *Applies to Yearlings As Well.***
- Intermediate Non Pro Weanling & Yearling Classes: These classes run within your regular non pro/open/color and obe classes, you must enter corresponding non pro and open classes, special reduced entry fees.
- All Color and OBE Classes Require Additional Entry Fees, They Run Concurrent.
- Page 4 lists the fees for the weanlings and yearlings. It's easy to follow your fees as you look **“side to side across the page”** by the date that you are paying your entry.
- **River Oaks Ranch \$30,000 Added Two-Year-Olds Plus Three Years & Over Limited Stakes:** All Breeds – Horses must Be Nominated Into WCHA Breeder's Program, Sired By Any Stallion That WAS EVER Enrolled With WCHA. 3 Divisions Within Each Class: Open – Non Pro – Color (Show concurrent)
- **Drug Testing:** We will be running random tests on horses of all ages in both halter and performance classes, any positive test is grounds for forfeiture of all winnings and suspension of associations.

INTERMEDIATE NON PRO WEANLING & YEARLING CLASSES: If you qualify to compete in Intermediate Non Pro Division You Must Also Enter & Compete In Corresponding Open & Regular Non Pro Class, Same Horse/Same Exhibitor. *Reduced Fees: The Entry Fee Into Regular Non Pro Class For An Intermediate Non Pro Is Only \$50, Furthermore, The Entry Fee Into The Open Division For Intermediate Non Pro **And/Or** Regular Non Pro Exhibitors Is Only \$100 Additional.*

- The Intermediate Non Pro Weanling Class Will Run Separate From Regular Non Pro & Open Class.
- The Intermediate Non Pro Yearling Classes Will Be Run Within The Regular Open/Non Pro Class.

Intermediate Non Pro Eligibility: Any Non Pro Exhibitor who has NOT won a World or Reserve World Title in AQHA, APHA or ApHC competition. The "Only Exception" is world/reserve titles in youth or AQHA Level 1 & 2 or titles in PHBA, ABRA, ARHA, PtHA. Immediate family members of WCHA Judges and Trainers are prohibited from competing in the Intermediate Non Pro division.

To compete in any Color or OBE futurity class each contestant must also be entered in the Intermediate, Non Pro or Open class.

- HORSE ELIGIBILITY: All Breed Stakes Classes – Two Year Olds & Also 3 Year And Older Horses
- Horses Must Fall Into The "Limited" Category: Horses that have NEVER WON a World Title in AQHA (Level 3), APHA, ApHC Are "Limited" And Are Eligible For Competition.
Exceptions: Horses that have won Solid Color World Show Class, Youth or AQHA Level 1 or 2 World title **and/or any horse who won a world title "as a weanling" can still compete as a limited horse, Reserve World Champions are still eligible to compete in Limited Classes.**
- Entries can be sired by stallions that were "**EVER ENROLLED**" in the WCHA Breeder's Program.
- All Horses Must Also Be Nominated Into WCHA Nomination Program Prior To Entry, see special "catch up" nomination rates for these older horses even if NEVER nominated before.

“HALTER RULES & CONDITIONS”

Read Prior To Filling Out Your Entry Forms !!

- **After 5pm on Sunday, Sept 27TH Exhibitor Changes From A Non Pro To An Open Exhibitor Is Not Permitted.** After this time/date a non pro exhibitor can only be changed to another non pro who is a family member or an open exhibitor to another open exhibitor. The **“only exception”** to this rule is extreme injury or sickness to non pro exhibitor or if family emergency resulting in non pro to return home, an open exhibitor could then show their horse under hardship ruling. Abuse of this rule is grounds for forfeiture of purse money and/or suspension from the association !!
- **Weanling Splits:**
 - ✓ **Senior Split Will Be Foals Born Jan 1 - Jan 31st,**
 - ✓ **Median Split Will Be Foals Born February 1 - March 4th**
 - ✓ **Juniors Will Be Foals Born March 5th and later.**
 - Exhibitors can move a horse up into the older split if they had 2 juniors or 2 medians so that one exhibitor can show both horses.
 - **EQUAL Purse money in each split so if we end up with 25 in senior split and only 20 in median they still have as close to equal payouts as possible with the only exception being if one split has exceptionally large numbers or the other class with unusually small numbers or horses in the class.**
 - Summary: By having splits announced early this will allow competitors to plan ahead knowing exactly which classes their horses will show in. This will be helpful to both breeders and those looking to buy a specific age foal to fit into a senior, a median or a junior thus allowing more horses to compete at our event.

YEARLING MARE SPLITS: BY SPLITTING OUR YEARLING MARE CLASSES THIS ALLOWS AN EXHIBITOR TO COMPETE WITH BOTH A JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARLING Mare!

- ✓ **Mares Born Jan 1-Feb 7 will be in the Senior Division,**
- ✓ **Mares Born Feb 8th and later will be in the Junior Division.**
- ✓ **“If an exhibitor has 2 junior mares they could move one mare up into the senior division.**
- ✓ This split would also apply to geldings or stallions if we had over 40 entries “check in” at the show.

DRESS ATTIRE: Professional attire is required for both men and women to wear suit, sports coat, jacket or blazer with slacks. A tie is required for men. A top with a traditional collar is preferred or crew neck with **High Profile Neckline** to be wore under a blazer for women.

- This will be the policy for exhibitors competing in all WCHA Championship Events including the WCHA Supreme Championship Show, WCHA Breeder’s Futurity, Big Money Futurity and Rising Star Futurity. **Any exhibitor that does not comply with the attire rule will not be placed in the class.** By entering a WCHA class, you agree to adhere to all show rules of the association.



- ALL HORSES MUST FIRST BE “NOMINATED” INTO WCHA BREEDER’S FUTURITY PROGRAM PRIOR TO ENTERING !!! Furthermore, To Be Eligible for Competition in Future Years Horses Must Be Nominated As A Weanling and Each And Every Year Thereafter, see exception for offspring of stallions never before nominated into WCHA Futurity Program in nomination forms for yearlings and older horses AND our “Catch Up Option”.
- **Special Nomination Rate For Two and Older Horses:** If a horse two years and older was not nominated in prior years they can still be nominated and be eligible to compete with reduced “catch-up nomination”. See nomination form.
- **Non-Pro Eligibility:** Exhibitor has not shown, sold a horse for a third party, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, including commissions for selling a horse, nor received compensation for instructing another person in riding, training or showing a horse, for 3 years prior to application for Non-Pro membership. Payment of entry fees and/or expenses by anyone other than the Non-Pro, his/her immediate family, or a corporation, partnership or other business entity in which the Non-pro and/or a member of his/her immediate family are the sole and only owner, shall be considered remuneration. A Non-Pro cannot be an approved horse show judge for any association or have judged an open, 4-H or breed show for the past 36 months. **By entering every Non-Pro exhibitor declares that they are in full compliance of WCHA Non-Pro requirements.** Violations will be grounds for forfeiture of all prizes, prize monies and of all fees paid and possible suspension from the association.
- **Intermediate Non Pro Eligibility:** Any Non-Pro who has not won a World or Reserve World Title in AQHA, APHA or ApHC competition. The “Only Exception” is world/reserve titles in youth or AQHA Level 1 & 2 or world titles won in PHBA, ABRA, ARHA, PtHA. Immediate family members of WCHA judges and trainers are prohibited from competing in the Intermediate Non-Pro division. If you enter the Intermediate class, you are “required to enter the corresponding non pro and the open class” with SAME exhibitor.
 - ✓ Intermediate Non-Pro Weanling & Yearling Divisions: If a non pro qualifies as an Intermediate Non Pro they can enter this division held within the Open/Non Pro/Color/OBE weanling or yearling class.
 - There are 3 splits within the weanling classes: Senior-Median-Junior which means that each division will have Intermediate Non-Pro payouts and awards in each division.
 - Intermediate Non-Pro Exhibitors **MUST** also enter their corresponding Non-Pro AND Open Class. WCHA offers a “reduced entry fee” for Intermediate Exhibitors to enter corresponding Open and Non Pro classes.
- **Owner-Breeder-Exhibitor Classes (OBE):** In order to be eligible for Owner/Breeder/Exhibitor Awards, you must meet the following relationship criteria: Exhibitor is the owner, spouse, children, parent, stepchildren, grandchildren, sibling or legal guardianship of the original “breeder” of the horse entered.
- **RIVER OAKS RANCH - \$30,000 ADDED “Limited 2 Year Old & Limited 3 Yrs And Over Eligibility”:** Horses that have NEVER WON a World Title in AQHA, APHA, ApHC Are “Limited” And Are Eligible For Competition.
 - **Exceptions:**
 - ✓ Horses that have won Solid Color Class World Title, Youth or AQHA Level 1 or 2 World title or world titles in PHBA, ABRA, ARHA, PtHA.
 - ✓ And/or any horse who won a world title in APHA/ApHC/AQHA “as a weanling” can still compete as a limited horse.
 - ✓ Reserve World Champions of any breed are still eligible to compete in WCHA Limited Classes.
- **Ownership Requirement:** Horses entered in a Non Pro class must provide registration papers showing horse is owned by the exhibitor or family member. **Leased horses are NOT eligible for competition**, furthermore if horses are transferred merely for non pro to compete and is later transferred back to original owner this may be cause for suspension from the association. **Fair Competition Within Our Non Pro Ranks Is Imperative !!!!!**

WCHA Breeder's Futurity Rules and Conditions Continued:

- **DRUG TESTING:** APHA Drug Testing Rules and Regulations apply within the WCHA Breeders Championship – Big Money – Rising Star Futurities. By entering a futurity class, owners/trainers/exhibitors are subject to random drug testing, any positive test is for cause for possible suspension/fines and all entry fees forfeited. Any owner/exhibitor/trainer that is suspended from an affiliate breed association has a reciprocal rule of WCHA and all parties are ineligible for WCHA competition during term of suspension.
- **Change Of Ownership:** Horses can be sold at any time and remain eligible with an additional \$50 Change Fee. New owners and exhibitors must hold WCHA membership. Registration papers may be compared to each entry to verify markings. Membership: All owners, exhibitors and stallion owners must be members of WCHA.
- **Refunds and Substitutions:** A partial refund will be issued with veterinary death certificate (Amount paid less a \$100 processing fee) *or the owner can substitute another horse at no additional fees.* Death Certificate must be submitted prior to when the class is run so that entry fees can be deducted from the purse. No other substitutions or refunds allowed.
- All horses must be registered with respective breed associations. No pending papers will be accepted. Weanlings: Please send copy of registration papers as soon as papers are processed by breed registries AND update your member portal with horse's registration numbers and names.
- **Draws:** Weanlings and Yearlings will enter the arena and be lined up according to foaling date, youngest horses first. Two Year and Older Horses Draws based on when entry was submitted.
- **Use of a safety lead, lip chain, lip cord is allowable in all age groups.**
- **Color Classes:** Color classes will run concurrently within the corresponding Open/Non Pro class. APHA, ApHC, PHBA, ABRA, ARHA are eligible. Each entry must have respective breed association registration to show in a color class.
 - Example: Palomino entry must have corresponding registry with PHBA and dual registered horses must provide 2 sets of papers. Solid horses with APHA or ApHC registries are eligible for competition.
- 10% of entry fees will be retained by WCHA to assist in covering the cost of arena rental, judges and awards.
- **Coaching From Sidelines is strictly prohibited, violation of this rule is grounds for disqualification and by entering a horse in these futurities all parties are aware of this rule.**
- **Setting Up for Inspection –** All exhibitors in the Open division and Non-Pro division that do not get their conformation horse set up and standing still long enough to allow the judge(s) to look at all 4 sides of the horse may be disqualified. Reasonable consideration will be given to Non-pros before disqualification.
- **Unsportsmanlike conduct** or any other form of misconduct that is irresponsible, illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating, threatening or abusive is prohibited by any person on the show grounds either directly or indirectly to a show official, judge, show management or other exhibitors involved within any WCHA sponsored events is strictly prohibited. Any violation will be grounds for permanent suspension from WCHA.
- No person shall treat any horse in a **cruel or inhumane manner** either in or out of the show ring especially excessive jerking on safety lead, lip chain, lip cord or chain under chin of horse and is grounds for disqualification from participation. Upon inspection if any horse has abrasions on gums this horse will be disqualified.
- *When an entry is placed all parties hereby release World Conformation Horse Association, APHA and their respective directors, officers, members, volunteers, employees and lessors of premises from all liability, claims, losses or damages arising from injury, death and/or property damages occurring as a result of participation in the activities, (and participant's family, heirs, agents, representatives).*

Additional Rules & Conditions For WCHA Breeder's Championship Show And Futurity:

- **LEND A HAND RULE:** Upon completion of the judging, and exhibitors are retired to the rail, each contestant will be allowed to have ONE helper enter the arena to "lend a hand" by holding the horse, providing a bottle of water or cold towel and to join in the awards presentation with the exhibitor. The helper could be a trainer or family member. **The helper "MUST" wear boots, hat and collared shirt.**
- **DISABILITY VARIANCE RULE:** Any non pro exhibitor with a physical disability that prohibits them from participating in the "trot through" portion of the pattern may use a designated leader to lead the horse through the pattern, once the horse is through the "trot-through" the exhibitor will then take the horse prior to setting up for individual inspection. **A letter from the exhibitor's doctor verifying the disability must be submitted to show manager two weeks prior to competition before a Disability Variance is granted.** A designated handler assigned by show management or another non pro competitor to assist in this variance, no professional trainer allowed to assist. The designated handler will "stand by, no closer than 15 feet of the exhibitor without any verbal assistance to assist if exhibitor needs to be excused from the class. The handler can assist in leading the horse after the judging is completed or if there is re-judging under individual judges, the "exhibitor" must set the horse up for inspection without assistance when required.

CLASS PROCEDURE: These rules apply at ALL WCHA EVENTS !!

A. Only the exhibitor and the horse are to be allowed to enter the alleyway according to the established draw or working order. There will be no trainers, parents or grooms with the exhibitor or horse once the exhibitor breaks the plane of the alleyway or in sight of judges is arena set up is allowable.

B. Each exhibitor and horse must complete the prescribed pattern. The pattern is as follows: Horses will walk *straight* to the judge (*walk horse directly to judge*) one at a time. As the horse approaches, the judge will step to the right (left of the horse) to enable the horse *straight and to the trot to the right* of a cone placed approximately 30-50 feet away. At the cone, the horse will continue trotting, turn to the left and continue trotting until it reaches the next cone *which will be placed approximately 30-50 feet away.*

C. In multi-judged shows, the judges may inspect as the horse enters at the walk, one judge will ask for the exhibitor to show the horses teeth. All stallions and mares will be inspected for parrot mouth or monkey mouth. All stallions 2 years of age or older will be inspected for cryptorchidism.

D. After trotting, horses will be lined up head to tail for individual inspection by the judge.

E. Loose horse – Any horse that becomes detached from its handler and is no longer under control may be disqualified, however the rules of the event and decision of show management will take precedence. If the initial horse exhibiting poor mannerisms causes other exhibitors to lose their horse, only the initiating horse may be disqualified.

F. Disruptive horse – Any horse that is disruptive, a danger to the exhibitor, other exhibitors or horses may be disqualified at the judge's discretion.

G. Neurologic horse – If a horse is determined to have a neurological condition and is considered unsound, the horse may be disqualified at the judge’s discretion.

EXHIBITOR PROCEDURE

- A. The exhibitor should track the HORSE directly to and away from the judge.
- B. The exhibitor should make every attempt to track the horse on the first track.
- C. The exhibitor should begin trotting after the judge/judges move to the right and continue trotting to the immediate right of the first cone, continue trotting and make a smooth left turn then **continue trotting to the next cone** which will be placed approximately 30-50 feet away.
- D. The exhibitor shall have a maximum of 3 attempts in order to execute the tracking segment of the class. If the exhibitor fails to execute the tracking segment in 3 attempts, the exhibitor will be excused and disqualified.

By “entering these futurities and stakes classes” all participants (owners/trainers/exhibitors) agree to read and be bound by all terms and conditions set forth.
