## Big Money Futurity Rules and Conditions:

- Exhibitors In The Big Money Futurity Must Qualify As “ A Non Pro”. A Non Pro Exhibitor has not shown, sold a horse for a third party, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, including commissions, nor received compensation for instructing another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse, for five years previous to application for Non-pro membership. **Payment of entry fees and/or expenses** by anyone other than the Non-pro, his/her immediate family, or a corporation, partnership or other business entity in which the Non-pro and/or a member of his/her immediate family are the sole and only owner, shall be considered remuneration. A Non-pro cannot be an approved horse show judge for any association or have judged an open, 4-H or breed show for the past 60 months. **By entering every Non-pro exhibitor declares that they are in full compliance of WCHA Non-Pro requirements.** Violations will be grounds for forfeiture of all prizes, prize monies and of all fees paid and possible suspension from the association. **Youth Are Also Eligible To Compete As Non Pro's !!!**
- 1) Weanlings/Yearlings/Two Yr Olds are made eligible by the stallion owner or agent paying an annual stallion nomination fee. Only foals from stallions paid in “same” year are eligible for competition.
  - 2) Offspring by nominated stallions must first be “nominated into WCHA Breeder’s Nomination Program to being eligible for competition in Big Money Futurity and other WCHA events.
  - 3) Two Yr Old & Three & Over Classes: Any horse that has won a World Title in AQHA (Level 3), APHA or ApHC competition is not eligible to compete. **However, horses that have won SPB or Youth or Select World Titles can still compete as a limited horse and horses that won APHA World Title same week are still eligible. Any 2 yr or older class with less than 3 entries may be cancelled with entry and nomination fees refunded.**
  - 4) All Exhibitors AND Owners of each entry MUST BE MEMBERS OF WCHA
  - 5) **WCHA does not allow horse leases, sole or family ownership of a horse is required, furthermore if it is discovered that a horse was transferred into a non pro’s name solely to compete in a WCHA event and later transferred back to original owner this is grounds for suspension from the association.**
  - 6) Change Of Ownership: Horses can be sold at any time and new owner can compete with **\$50.00 Change Fee**, new owners and exhibitors of entry must be members of WCHA.
  - 7) Weanlings will enter the pen by foaling date and judges will be notified that horses are lined up youngest to oldest in each line up.
  - 8) 10% of entries will be retained by WCHA to help cover cost of arena rental, judges, awards.
  - 9) Color Requirements: Each horse MUST provide proof of registration with APHA, PHBA, ARHA, ABRA or ApHC. Solids are eligible for competition.
  - 10) Safety leads, safety cords, lip chains are eligible equipment, **HOWEVER upon inspection any area of the horse’s gum that is raw is reason for disqualification. Excessive jerking on a lead shank either in or out of arena is grounds for disqualification.**
  - 11) Refunds or Substitutions: Partial refunds with a signed veterinary death certificate, total amount paid less \$100 processing fee or owner has option to substitute another entry. No Other Substitutions or Refunds For Any Reason. APHA has separate rules for stall refund.
  - 12) **Unsportsmanlike conduct** or any other form of misconduct that is inhumane to an animal or anyone that uses profane language , is intimidating, threatening or abusive to another contestant, official or spectator by any person is prohibited to be on the show grounds either directly or indirectly involved with WCHA. Any person suspended from an affiliate breed association is ineligible to compete within WCHA events. Violation is grounds for forfeiture of purse money, prizes and disqualification from future WCHA events.
  - 13) LEND A HAND RULE: After the judging of each class has been completed, and the competitors are excused to the rail, each contestant can have ONE helper enter the arena and “lend a hand” by holding the horse and/or bringing a refreshing bottle of water or towel. Helpers MUST be attired appropriately: Boots, Hat and Collared Shirt.
  - 14) Disability Variance Rule: Any non pro exhibitor with physical disability that prohibits them from participating in “trot through” portion of the pattern may use a designated leader take horse through the pattern, exhibitor will then take the horse prior to setting up for individual inspection. A letter from the exhibitor’s doctor verifying the disability must be submitted to futurity manager prior to competition before being granted a variance.
