Purpose Of WCHA Big Money Futurity

- To promote the halter horse industry, regardless of breed or color of the horse, by providing a futurity program for "NON-PRO EXHIBITORS" to compete against other non-pro exhibitors (youth and/or amateurs).

Format

- Foals/Yearlings are made eligible by the stallion owner or agent paying an annual nomination fee.
Only foals from stallions paid in "same" year are eligible for competition.

Futurity Classes

- All horses shown must have appropriate breed registration papers and meet all ownership requirements to show that particular horse as an amateur or youth.
- All weanlings will enter the pen by foaling date and judges will be instructed to consider their age when judging.
- There are three yearling classes: yearling fillies, yearling geldings, and yearling stallions.
- There are 4 weanling classes: junior and senior weanling fillies, junior and senior weanling colts (stallions and geldings are combined in the colt division).
- A \$25 office/awards fee will be assessed to each entry.

Miscellaneous

- Color Requirements: Each horse MUST provide proof of registration with APHA or ApHC. Solids are eligible.
- APHA rules will apply regarding lip chains or lip cords.
- Horses substituted only with vet signed death certificate. Substitutions must meet all eligibility requirements. No refunds.
- LEND A HAND RULE: After the judging of each class has been completed, and the competitors are excused to the rail, each contestant can have ONE helper enter the arena and "lend a hand" by holding the horse and/or bringing a refreshing bottle of water or towel. Helpers MUST be attired appropriately: boots, hat and collared shirt and participate in the awards presentation with the competitor.
- Entries MAY be drug tested, any positive tests will result in possible suspension and forfeiture of all prize winnings after full review of a case by case basis.
