Three Phases of Competition: Basic Ranch Pattern – Ranch Rail Pleasure – Form to Function Conformation

ENTRY FEE: A Maximum Of 20 SLOTS OFFERED INTO EACH CLASS @ \$1000 PER SLOT This is a "Slot Class" for Two- Year- Old Prospects registered with APHA, AQHA, or ApHC.

- Offering 20 slots @ \$1000 per slot if slot is purchased by June 1, 2019.
- Slots will be "reserved" on a first come basis
 - Slots can be reserved NOW with \$500 down payment; the balance won't be due until June 1st.
 - o Any remaining slots available after June 1st can be purchased for \$1500, All Slots Close on Aug 20.
 - o Payment Plan Available.
- Horses MUST BE NAMED BY August 20, 2019. No Exceptions!!
- 100% of the slot entry fees, less 10% office fee, will be added to the purse.
- A minimum of 10 places will be paid with additional prizes for every entry.
- Owner and Exhibitor must be Current WCHA members.
- Eligibility Requirements: Each entry must be sired by a stallion nominated into the WCHA Futurity Program within the past 11 years. (A list of eligible stallions is available.)
- Slots can be re-sold but notification must be made to WCHA within 10 days of sale. Purchasers of slots in 2019 will have preference to purchase a slot in 2020.
- Horses will compete in versatility pattern designed to test athletic abilities as a "versatility prospect".
- Final scores based on Highest Combination of Performance and Conformation Placings:
 - o 30% of score based on pattern work

VERSATILITY PROSPECT CLASS RULES

- 1. This is a Stakes Class for Two- Year- Old horses registered with AQHA, APHA or ApHC.
- a. Entries must be sired by a stallion that is currently or was previously enrolled into the WCHA Breeder's Futurity Program. (Ask for list of eligible stallions)
 - b. Owner and Exhibitor Must be WCHA members.
 - c. Exhibitor changes are allowed up to 10:00 AM prior to the class.
- d. No changes in exhibitor from one phase of competition to the next unless an exhibitor has multiple entries. If Non Pro the multiple entry the second entry must be shown by a non pro.
- 2. These are "Maiden Classes" meaning, the horse can NEVER have competed in any "performance" competition of any kind.
 - a. Prior halter competition is allowable.
- 3. Horses MUST Be Named By August 20, 2019. No horse substitutions after this date.
- 4. Horses will be inspected and markings compared to registration papers.
- 5. No refunds for any reason. Violation of the "maiden rule" will be cause for forfeiture of all fees.
- 6. Horses may be drug tested and any positive test will result in suspension of all prize monies.
- 7. Horses may be clipped, manes banded with longer manes preferred, tail extensions allowed.
- 8. Equipment:
 - a. Minimal silver but silver will not count over non-silver equipment
 - b. Silver show halters are allowed.
 - c. Hackamore or Snaffle Bit
 - i. Riders will ride two handed
 - d. Breast collar and rear cinch is acceptable.
- 9. A specific pattern will include the following Mandatory &/or Optional Maneuvers: Exact Pattern Will Be Posted by August 20th, one month prior to competition.

Pattern Will Be Suitable for Two- Year- Old Prospects: 30% of Total Score

The pattern will include the following mandatory maneuvers:

Walk, jog, extended jog, lope, extended lope, lead change with a simple or flying change, stop and back.

Optional: Rollback, turns, side-pass, Walk or Trot over logs

Ranch Rail Class: (See NSBA Ranch Rail Pleasure Class Rules) 30% of Total Score

Horses will walk, trot, lope in both directions and may be asked to extend each gait.

Conformation Class: 40% of Total Score

All horses will be unsaddled at same time, 2 grooms allowed in for 10 minutes to prep horses to compete in halter class, all sexes show in one class.

10. Additional payouts and prizes depending on additional sponsors for: Highest Non-Pro/Youth Rider, Highest Placing Color Horses, Highest Placing Horse Within Each Leg of Competition.
