- Combined Open and Non Pro Class, Non Pro Exhibitors Must Enter The Open Division, Non Pro's Can Earn Monies In Both Open And Non Pro Divisions. Each Exhibitor Can Enter/Compete With Two Horses, See Rules.
- Eligibility Requirements: Each entry must be sired by a stallion that has ever been nominated into the WCHA Futurity Program. (A list of eligible stallions is available, over 300 stallions have been nominated)
- All Horses MUST Also Be Nominated Into WCHA Breeder's Program, a discounted Performance Only Nomination Is Still Available.
- Final scores based on Combination of each horse's placing in Conformation Class and Longe Line
 - o 30% Of Final Score Based On "Scored Placing" With-In The Conformation Class
 - o 70% Of Final Score Based on Placing In The Longe Line Demonstration

WCHA LONGE LINE CLASS RULES

- 1. This is a stakes class for yearling mares, geldings or stallions that are nominated into WCHA Performance.
 - a. Entries must be sired by a stallion that is currently or was previously enrolled into the WCHA Breeder's Futurity Program in the past. (Over 300 stallions have been enrolled)
 - b. Final Score Based On 70% Of Working Portion and 30% Of Conformation Score.
 - c. Horses MUST Be nominated prior to entering, yearlings that were not nominated as weanling can still become eligible for longe line class with a "performance only nomination" without penalty. See Performance Only Nomination Form.
 - d. A maximum of two horses to be shown by one exhibitor, for conformation portion of class another exhibitor can show the horse in conformation class but if non pro entry that conformation exhibitor must be another non pro. Exhibitor changes are allowed up to 5pm the night before the class.
- 2. All Exhibitors "must" enter the open division within the class. Non Pro's can enter the non pro division held within the open class with a flat rate entry fee of \$100, this will allow the non pro to compete for both non pro and open purse monies. Open Class Payouts: ½ class plus one placing, Non Pro: Top 3 placings
- 3. Horses will first enter the arena and be called out individually for longe line work, depending on number of entries there may be two circles used for the longe line demonstations. After working portion of the class all horses will line up for a "scored" conformation class.
- 4. Conformation Class, 30% Value Of Final Results: Each judge will assign a score to each horse between -3 to +3 of a base score of 70 points, horses will receive a score somewhere between 67 and 73 with potential half point increments. Then that numerical total would be multiplied by 30% which is conformation value of class.
- 5. <u>No refunds except in the death of an entry</u>. Horses may be drug tested and any positive test will result in suspension of all prize monies. Horses will be inspected and markings compared to registration papers.
- 6. Equipment: Horses may be shown in a regular or show type halter. For the conformation class a lead shank such as used in halter or showmanship classes may be used, no lip chains will be allowed. For the longe line demonstration the only attachment to the halter is the longe line. The longe line may not exceed 30 feet in length with a snap to the halter. It is permissible to use a longe whip, however, disqualification will occur anytime the exhibitor strikes the horse at any time during the demonstration.
- 7. The purpose of showing a yearling on a longe line is to demonstrate that the horse has the movement, manners/expression/attitude and conformation to become a future competitor under saddle. A longeing demonstration lasting one and one-half minutes (90 seconds). The exhibitor will be given a "start signal" to present the horse at all three gaits (walk, trot, lope or canter) in both directions, any horse that does not exhibit these gaits in both directions will be disqualified. If a horse is playing on the longe line it shall not count against the horse, however, the judge will penalize for excessive bucking, or running off, stumbling, or displaying attitudes that are uncomplimentary to pleasure horses. Falling down will constitute disqualification. Exhibitors are encouraged to exhibit their horse making full use of a 25 foot radius. At the end of one and one-half minutes the signal will be given to signify the end of the demonstration.
- 8. NO LEASES ALLOWED. Any late purchases will be asked to show proof of purchase and proof of transfer of ownership with breed association.
- 9. Attire: Conventional Western Attire is mandatory: except if the prospect is considered to be a hunter prospect then conventional English attire is suggested.
